ORIGIN & HISTORY

From Crisis to European Icon

Mirabilandia was born from a bold vision in the late 1980s, designed as a vast entertainment complex organized around a striking central lake. The park officially opened on **July 8, 1992**, immediately establishing itself as Italy's largest theme park by surface area. Its original architecture defined its identity, with attractions, shops, and restaurants radiating outward from the water, creating a unique landscape that blended thrill rides with expansive green spaces.

The early years were marked by ambitious investments, including the installation of Sierra Tonante, which became Italy's only wooden roller coaster and Europe's tallest in its category until 2001. However, despite these impressive features, the park struggled with declining visitor numbers due to management errors and insufficient marketing. By 1996, Mirabilandia faced near-bankruptcy, prompting a critical change in direction that would save the attraction from closure.

In 1997, new German managers took over, injecting fresh capital and modernizing the image of the park. This period saw the introduction of new attractions and improved operational strategies. Then, in 2006, the Spanish group Parques Reunidos acquired the park, bringing international expertise and significant investment. This takeover stabilized the business and allowed for the development of high-quality rides like Katun and iSpeed, transforming Mirabilandia into a competitive European destination.

Today, the park spans 750,000 square meters, divided into seven themed zones that cater to all ages. The addition of the Mirabeach water park in 2003, later doubled in size in 2004, further expanded its appeal. With a focus on family-friendly experiences and adrenaline-pumping coasters, Mirabilandia has successfully reinvented itself, maintaining its status as a premier leisure spot in the Emilia-Romagna region.

THE EXPERIENCE

Stepping through the gates of Mirabilandia, visitors are immediately greeted by the serene yet vibrant atmosphere of the central lake. The architecture is open and airy, with wide pathways lined with Mediterranean pines that offer shade and a sense of tranquility before the thrills begin. The air carries the scent of blooming flowers and distant music, setting a tone of relaxed excitement that invites exploration rather than rushing.

As you move deeper into the park, the energy shifts dramatically. The promise of the visit unfolds through a mix of visual spectacles and auditory cues: the roar of the Katun coaster echoing from the distance, the colorful facades of Far West Valley, and the playful sounds of Bimbopoli. It is a place where **family memories** are forged under the Italian sun, blending the comfort of nature with the adrenaline of modern engineering.



PREPARE YOUR VISIT

Practical information

ADDRESS

Savio, near the Pineta di Classe. Access via A14 motorway (Lugo-Ravenna exit) or bus/taxi from Ravenna.

OPENING HOURS

Generally open from April to October. Hours vary by season, check the official website.

FARES

Indicative adult price: 29,90 €. Family packages available. {promo}.

VISIT DURATION

Plan for a full day to explore the 7 themed zones. Two days are recommended if you include the Mirabeach water park or want to avoid stress.

PHOTOS

Taking personal photos is allowed everywhere in the park. Be aware of the shows on the central lake where certain angles may be reserved for professionals.

AUDIENCE

Perfect for families thanks to the Bimbopoli and Dinoland zones. Adults will enjoy the thrills of Katun and iSpeed. Accessible from a young age.

ORGANIZATION

Navigating the Seven Themed Zones

Zone 1: Bimbopoli & Dinoland

This area is dedicated to young children, featuring gentle rides like Leprotto Express and Santa Fè Express. The scenery is colorful and whimsical, designed to be safe and engaging for toddlers. Parents can enjoy the calm atmosphere while their kids experience their first roller coasters. It is the perfect starting point for families with small children.

Zone 2: Far West Valley & Route 66

These two adjacent zones offer a blend of nostalgia and action. Far West Valley features the Gold Digger wild mouse and Buffalo Bill Rodeo, set against a superb western backdrop. Route 66 adds an American retro vibe with the Desmo Race motorcycle coaster. Grouping these visits together saves time and enhances the thematic immersion.

Zone 3: Adventureland & Ducati World

Adventureland houses the park's flagship thrill rides, including Katun and iSpeed. These high-intensity coasters are best experienced early in the day when lines are shorter. Nearby, Ducati World offers a unique motorbike-themed experience, appealing to speed enthusiasts. This sector is the heart of the park's adrenaline offerings.

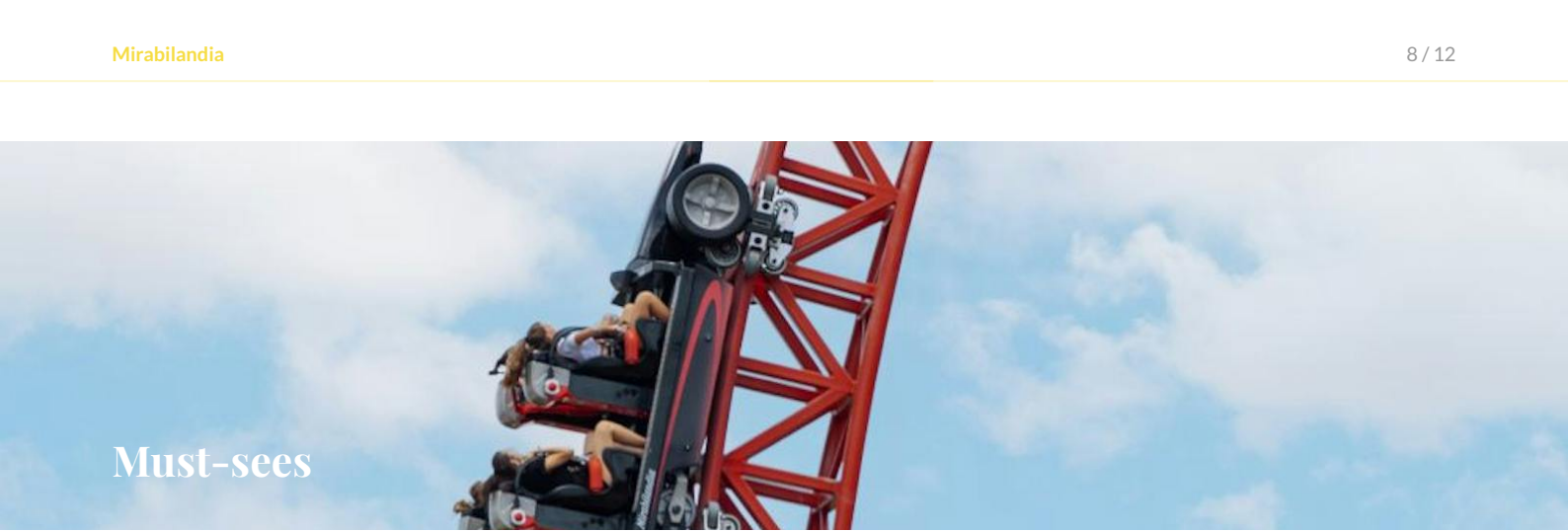

Must-Ride Attractions and Shows

01

Adventureland

Katun

One of the most intense inverted coasters in Europe, Katun delivers a thrilling ride with sharp inversions and high speeds. The track design ensures a continuous flow of excitement, making it a must-ride for thrill-seekers. Arriving early allows you to experience this ride without long waits.

💡 Built by Bolliger & Mabillard in 2000, it quickly became a symbol of the park's revival.

02

Adventureland

iSpeed

Launched in 2009, iSpeed is a launched coaster that accelerates from 0 to 100 km/h in seconds. The sensation of being pushed back into your seat is unmatched. Its sleek design and high speed make it a standout attraction for adults.

💡 It was one of the first launched coasters in Italy, marking a technological leap for the park.

03

Route 66

Desmo Race

This unique motorcycle coaster lets riders feel the wind rush past them as they race along the track. The experience is immersive, with the sound of engines adding to the excitement. It is a rare type of ride found in few parks worldwide.

💡 Installed in 2019, it brought a new level of innovation to the park's lineup.

04

Far West Valley

Gold Digger

A classic wild mouse coaster that offers a bumpy and fun ride suitable for both kids and adults. The western-themed scenery enhances the experience, making it a photo-worthy stop. It is less intense than the big coasters but still full of character.

💡 Originally installed in 1998, it has been a staple of the park since its early days.

05

Central Lake Area

Rio Bravo

This rapid river ride takes you on a scenic journey around the central lake. It is a relaxing way to see the park from a different perspective. The boat glides smoothly, offering views of the surrounding attractions and greenery.

💡 It was one of the original attractions at the park's opening in 1992.

06

Water Zone

Divertical

An aquatic coaster that combines the thrill of a roller coaster with the splash of water. Riders get wet as they navigate the twists and turns. It is a refreshing option during hot summer days.

💡 Opened in 2012, it added a new dimension to the park's water-based attractions.

07

Bimbopoli

Leprotto Express

A junior metal coaster designed for younger children. It is gentle and fun, providing a safe introduction to roller coasters. The bright colors and friendly characters make it appealing to little ones.

💡 It helps build confidence in young riders before they tackle bigger rides.

08

Central Lake

Lake Shows

Live performances on the central lake offer a break from the rides. The shows feature water effects, music, and lighting, creating a magical atmosphere. They are free with entry and provide a seated rest for tired legs.

💡 These shows pace the day and are a highlight for families with young children.

TIPS

Smart Strategies for Your Visit

TIMING

Arrive at opening to ride Katun and iSpeed before lines increase after 11h.

BILLET

Book online in advance, especially in summer, to ensure entry and avoid ticket booth queues.

PARCOURS

Group visits by zone, such as Far West + Route 66, to avoid crossing the park multiple times.

PHOTO

Take photos in Far West Valley for superb western scenery, but check reserved angles for lake shows.

PAUSE

Use the lake shows as a natural break to sit down and watch the performance.

ENFANTS

Alternate between Bimbopoli/Dinoland and adult rides to keep everyone satisfied.

AUDIOGUIDE

Download the official app for real-time wait times and show schedules instead of a physical guide.

CONFORT

Wear comfortable sneakers and bring water and sunscreen, as you will cover significant distance.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FAQ

Do I need to book my Mirabilandia ticket in advance?

Yes, online booking is highly recommended, especially in summer and on weekends. It ensures your entry and helps avoid long queues at the ticket booths. Remember to check the availability of specific time slots.

Does the entry ticket include the water park?

No, the standard ticket covers only the theme park. The Mirabeach water park often requires a separate ticket or a combined package. Carefully check the composition of your ticket when purchasing to avoid surprises.

Are there skip-the-line tickets available?

Options like the Flash Pass may be offered to reduce waiting times on popular attractions. Availability varies depending on the period and demand. Check special offers on the official website when booking.

Can I cancel or modify my booking?

Cancellation terms depend on the type of ticket purchased and the visit date. It is recommended to read the terms and conditions carefully when purchasing. Some flexible tickets allow free modifications up to 24h before.

How much time should I plan to visit Mirabilandia?

Allow a full day to fully enjoy the attractions and shows. If you want to include the water park or do everything without rushing, plan for two days. The park spans 750,000 m², which justifies this duration.

DID YOU KNOW?

Anecdotes & curiosities

European Wooden Record

Sierra Tonante was Italy's only wooden roller coaster and Europe's tallest in its category until 2001. This historic track marked the park's early identity before its removal. It remains a nostalgic reference for veteran visitors.

Spanish Revival

After near-bankruptcy in 1996, Parques Reunidos took over in 2006. This Spanish management brought investment and stability, transforming the park into a modern European destination. Their expertise in theme parks was crucial for the revival.

Twin Park in Brazil

There is a second Mirabilandia in Brazil, sharing the same logo and mascot. This twin park sometimes causes confusion but highlights the brand's international reach. The Brazilian version is spelled Mirabilândia.

Aquatic Expansion

The Mirabeach water park doubled in size in 2004, becoming a major success. The local climate helped drive attendance, making the water park a key part of the overall experience. New structures were added to enhance the aquatic fun.

AROUND THE MUSEUM

Located in Savio, near the Pineta di Classe, Mirabilandia offers more than just rides. Before or after your visit, explore the nearby **Ravenna Mosaics**, a UNESCO World Heritage site featuring exceptional Byzantine art, including the Mausoleum of Galla Placidia. For a peaceful stroll, the Pineta di Classe provides a lush forest of Mediterranean pines ideal for relaxation. If you are hungry, the Ristoranti Savio zone offers authentic Emilian-Romagnol specialties, such as traditional tortellini en brodo. Finally, if you have time, the urban beach at Marina di Ravenna provides a perfect seaside ending to your day, allowing you to unwind after an intense morning of thrills.
